
Gambela, Ethiopia. Save the Children (2017)


This sample includes data from 316 children living in the Jewi, Pugnido and Teirkidi refugee camps in Gambela, Ethiopia. These data were collected as part of a baseline study funded by the UBS Optimus Foundation. On average, children were 5.5 years old.

Average learning and development scores in IDELA domains


Distribution of Total IDELA scores



On average, children scored 55% correct on the IDELA assessment. There was a large range in children's score, but the most common score was 61-70% correct.





Average IDELA scores by child's age



Most children in the sample were 5 or 6 years old. On average, one additional year was associated with an additional 7 percentage points correct in overall IDELA score.

Distribution of children's gender





52% of children in the sample were female. Boys displayed significantly stronger skills on the overall IDELA score than girls by 4 percentage points.
