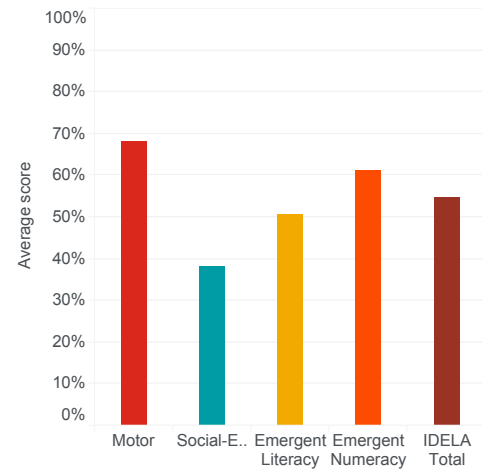


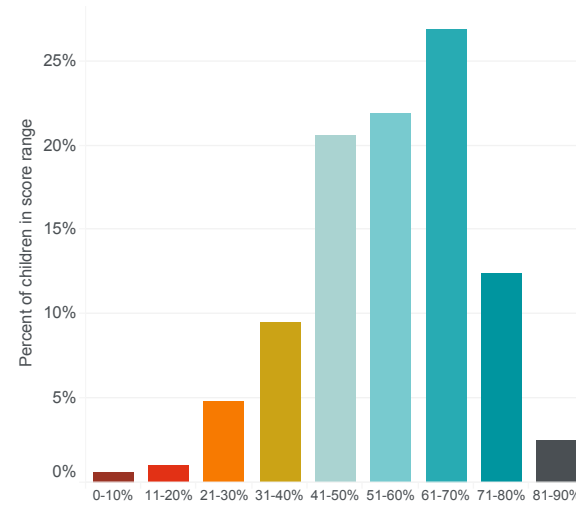
## Gambela, Ethiopia. Save the Children (2017)

This sample includes data from 316 children living in the Jewi, Pugnido and Teirkidi refugee camps in Gambela, Ethiopia. These data were collected as part of a baseline study funded by the UBS Optimus Foundation. On average, children were 5.5 years old.

### Average learning and development scores in IDELA domains

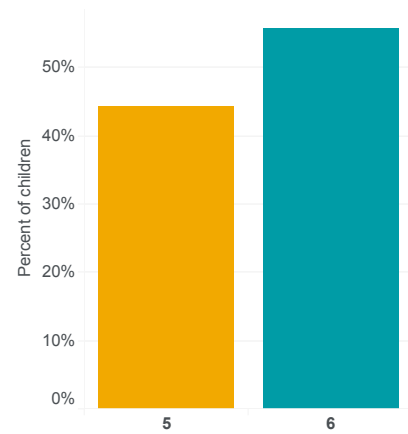


### Distribution of Total IDELA scores

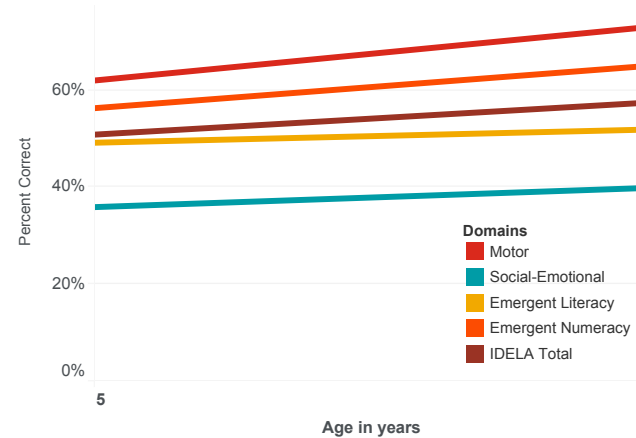


On average, children scored 55% correct on the IDELA assessment. There was a large range in children's score, but the most common score was 61-70% correct.

### Distribution of children's ages

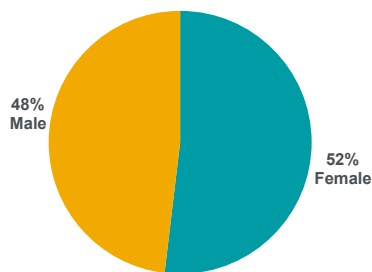


### Average IDELA scores by child's age

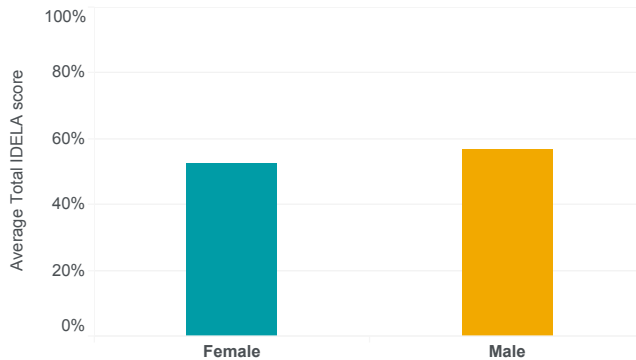


Most children in the sample were 5 or 6 years old. On average, one additional year was associated with an additional 7 percentage points correct in overall IDELA score.

52% of children in the sample were female. Boys displayed significantly stronger skills on the overall IDELA score than girls by 4 percentage points.
