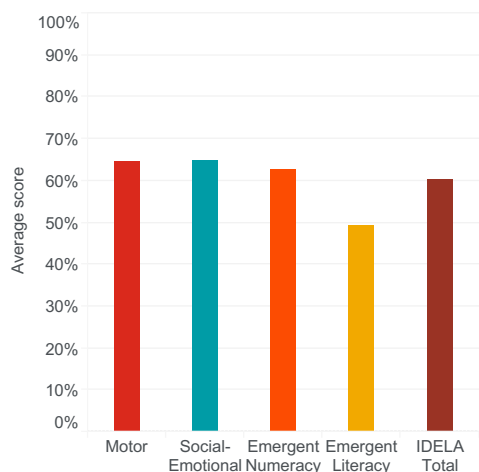


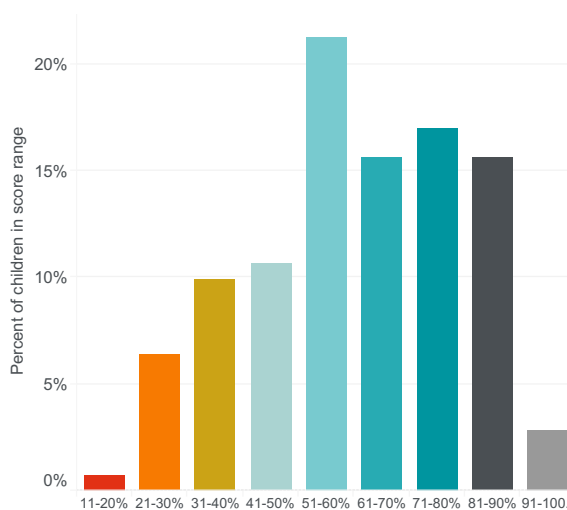
Gegharkunik and Lori, Armenia. Save the Children (2018)

This dataset includes data from 141 children in inclusive ECCD centers in Gegharkunik and Lori Provinces as well as Yerevan city in Albania. Background information on geographic sample the data was collected. The average age of children was 5.2 years. This data was collected as part of Save the Children's work in Albania on the third phase of the Action for Child Health and Education (ACHE) project.

Average learning and development scores in IDELA domains

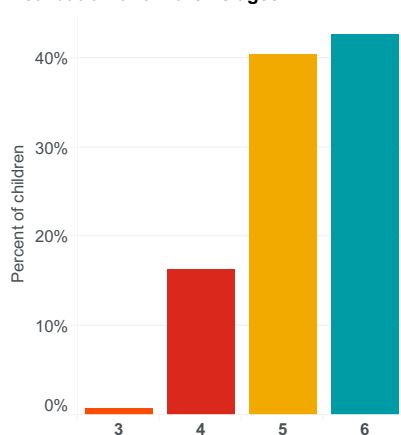


Distribution of Total IDELA scores

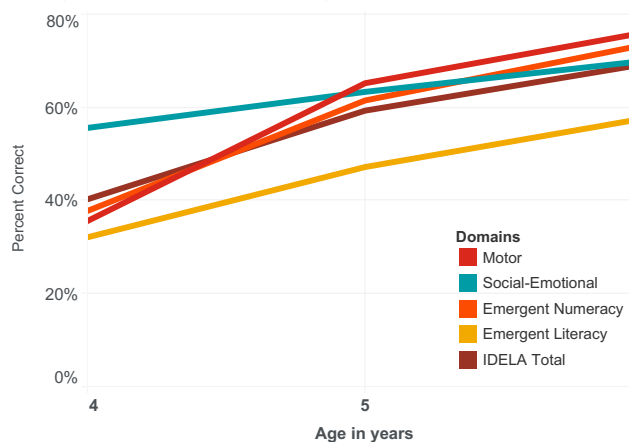


On average, children scored 60% correct on the IDELA assessment. The most common range of scores was 51 to 60%.

Distribution of children's ages

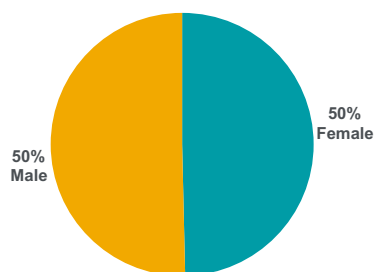


Average IDELA scores by child's age

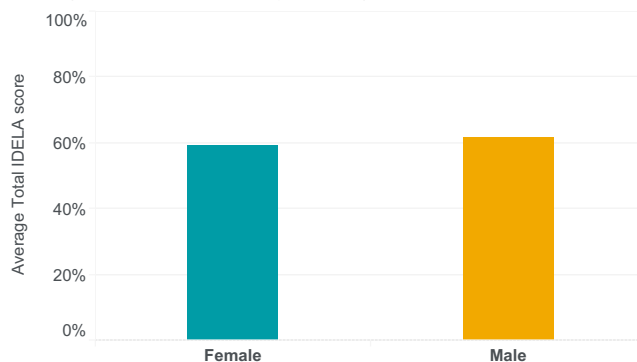


Most children in the sample were five or six years old. On average, one additional year was associated with an additional 13 percentage points correct in overall IDELA score.

50% of children in the sample were female. In this study no correlation was found between gender and total IDELA score.
