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Context

Community characteristics in Yen Bai and Quang Nam

- Yen Bai is a mountainous province in the north-western area of Vietnam
 - 50% of population is ethnic minority people
 - 25% poverty rate, triple of the national average
- Quang Nam Province, is a province in the South Central Coast Region of Vietnam
 - 15% overall poverty rate in the region
 - 85% of households are living under the poverty line in Tay Giang District, where the majority of the district population is Cotu ethnic minority group.

The program

- 2 phases of the **Supporting Emergent Literacy and Math Skills** program
- Focused in strengthening the **school readiness skills** among 2050 ethnic minority children 3-5 years old



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Research questions

1. What are the school readiness skills of children in the program after 2 phases into implementation?
 - a) How do these skills compare to the skills children in their same cohort started with?
2. What do the home learning environments of the children look like at endline?
 - a) How do these compare to the home learning environments of children in their same cohort at baseline?
- a) Are there any skills differences between the children of different provinces in the sample?
 - a) How do these differences compare to what was found at baseline?



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Research methods

Sample characteristics. General

The sample at endline was a new random sample taken at the same centers and following the same baseline cohort

Research methods

Data collection tools

1. The **IDELA¹ Child Assessment** has 24 child-reported items covering 4 areas and 2 Executive function items:
 - a) Areas:
 - Motor Development
 - Early Numeracy
 - Early Literacy
 - Socio-Emotional Development
 - b) Executive Function items
 - Short-Term Memory
 - Inhibitory Control
2. The **IDELA Caregiver Questionnaire** includes 5 different sections gathering information about the **homes and parental attitudes of the children in the study sample**, including ECD experience and educational expectations, home learning environment and parenting practices, parent self-efficacy, and socio-economic status.

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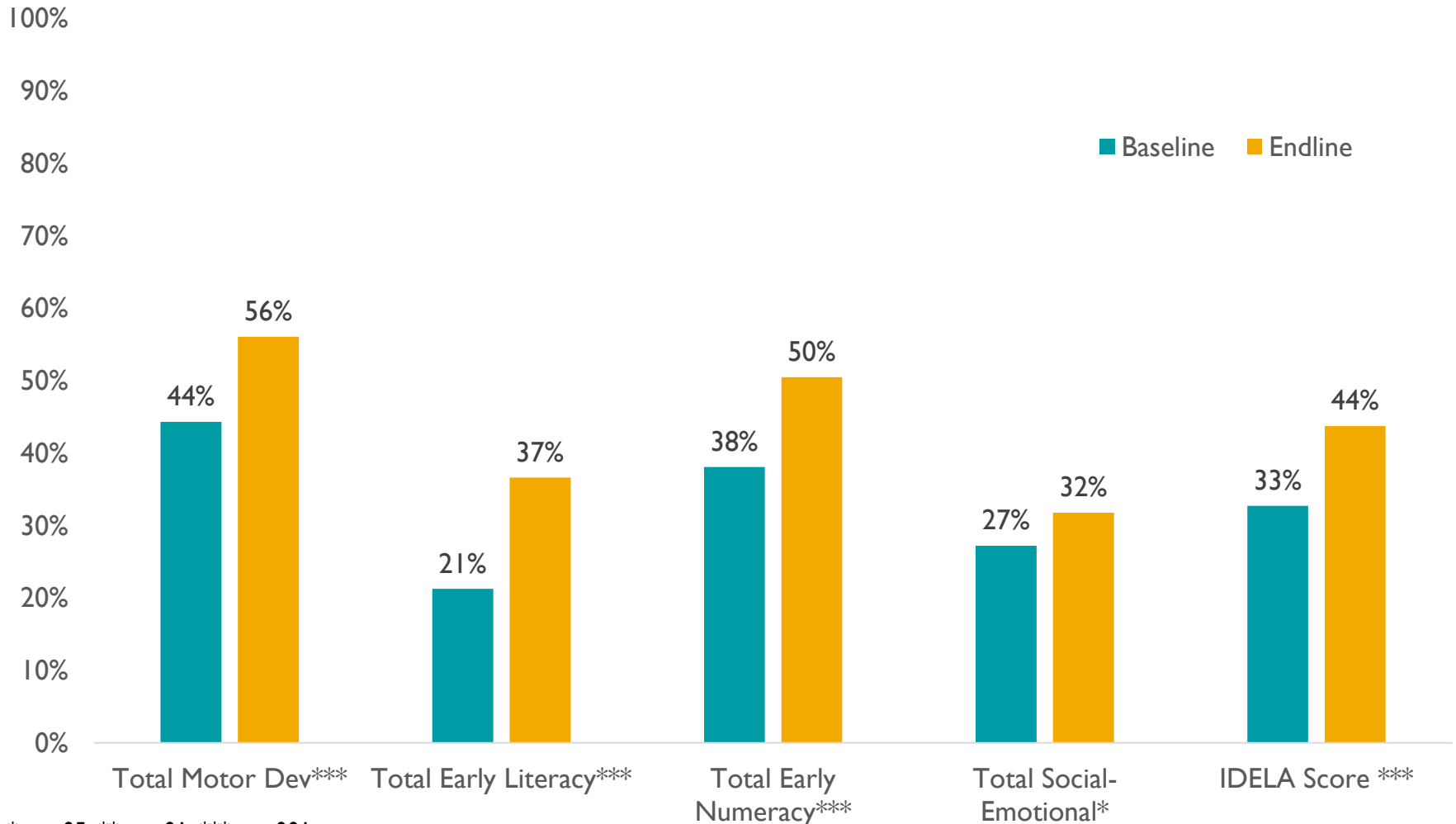

Skills. IDELA subtests

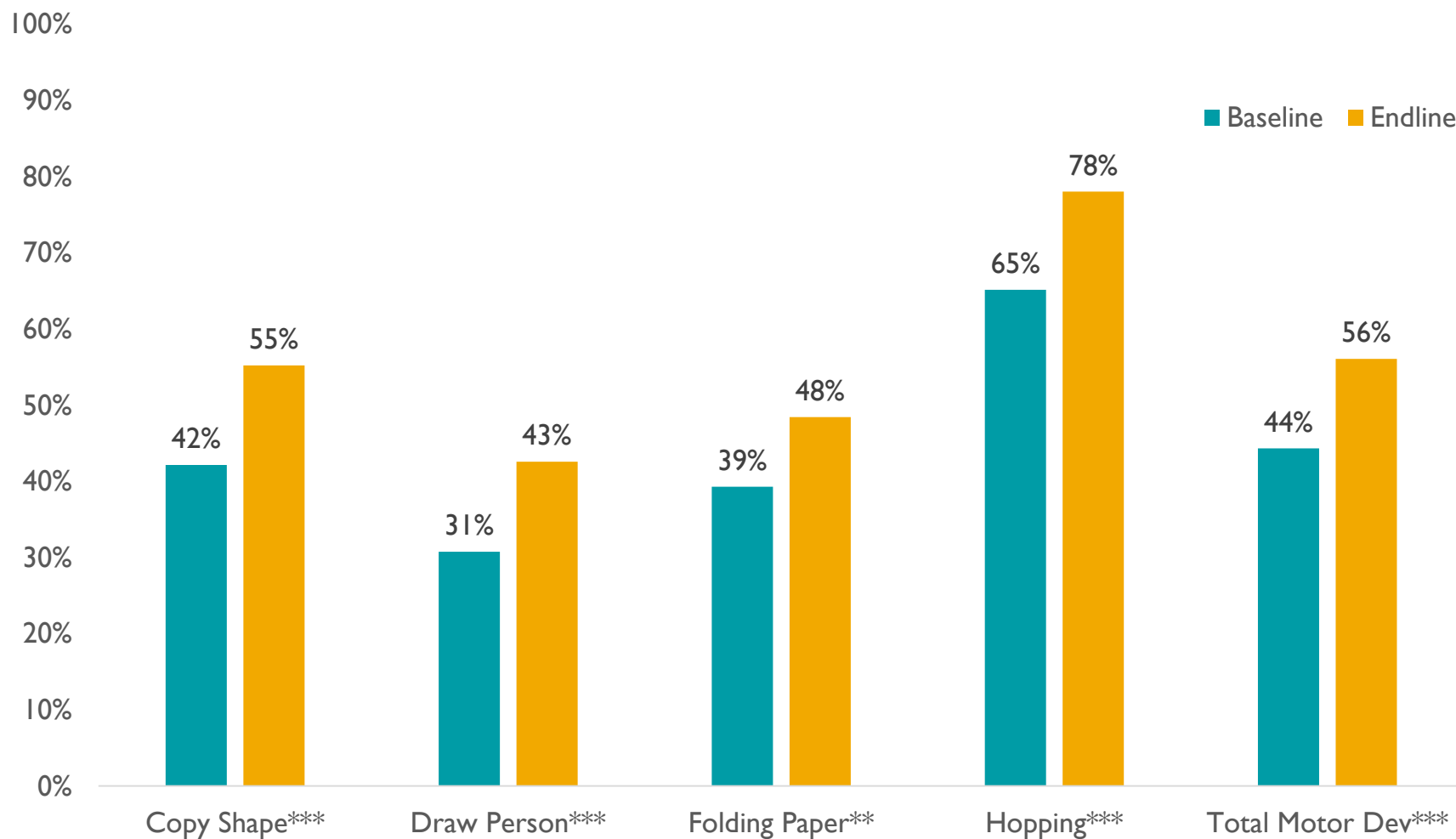
The skills of the endline sample are statistically higher in all subdomains

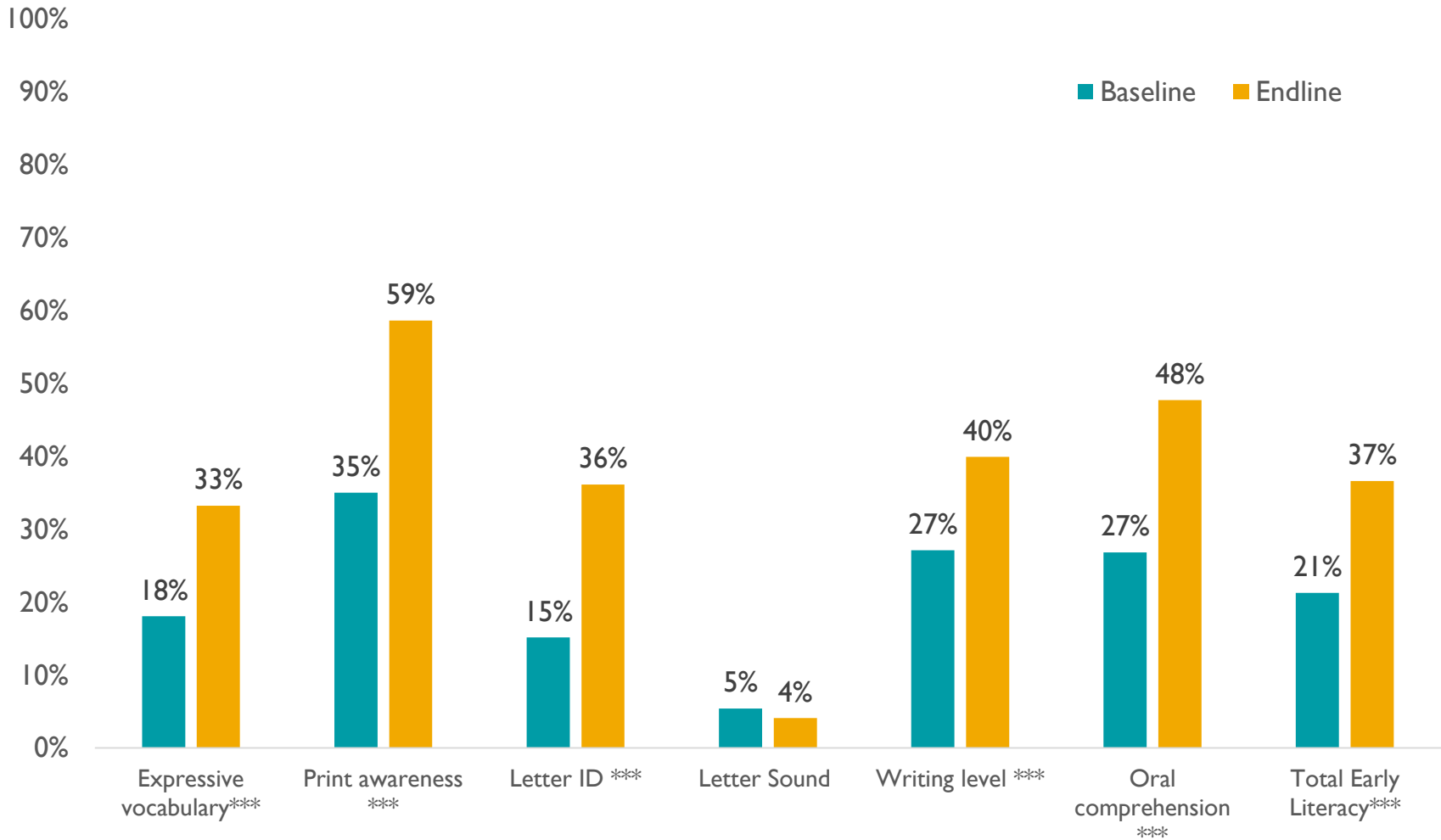
Skills. Motor Development

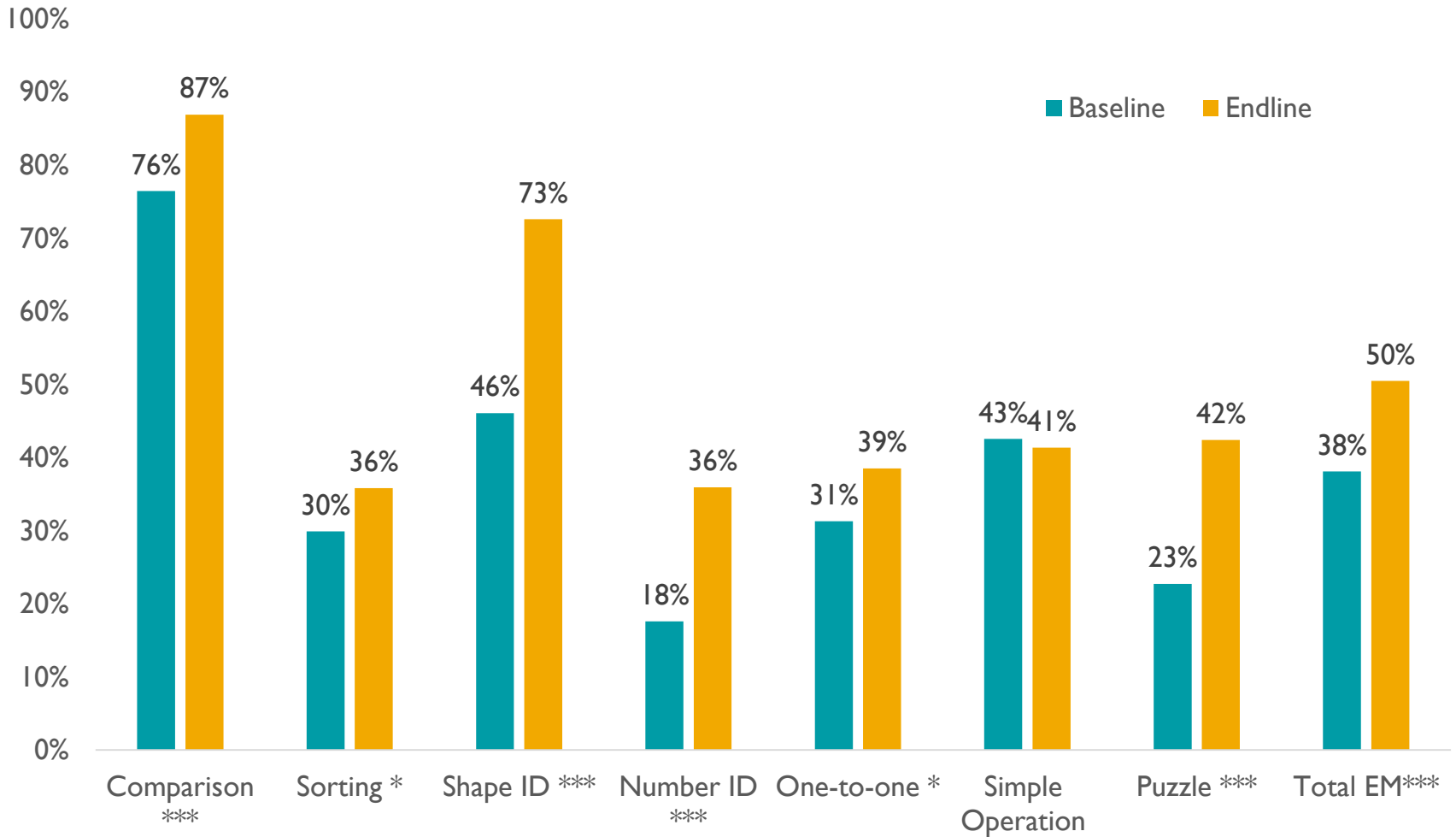
Skills. Emergent Literacy

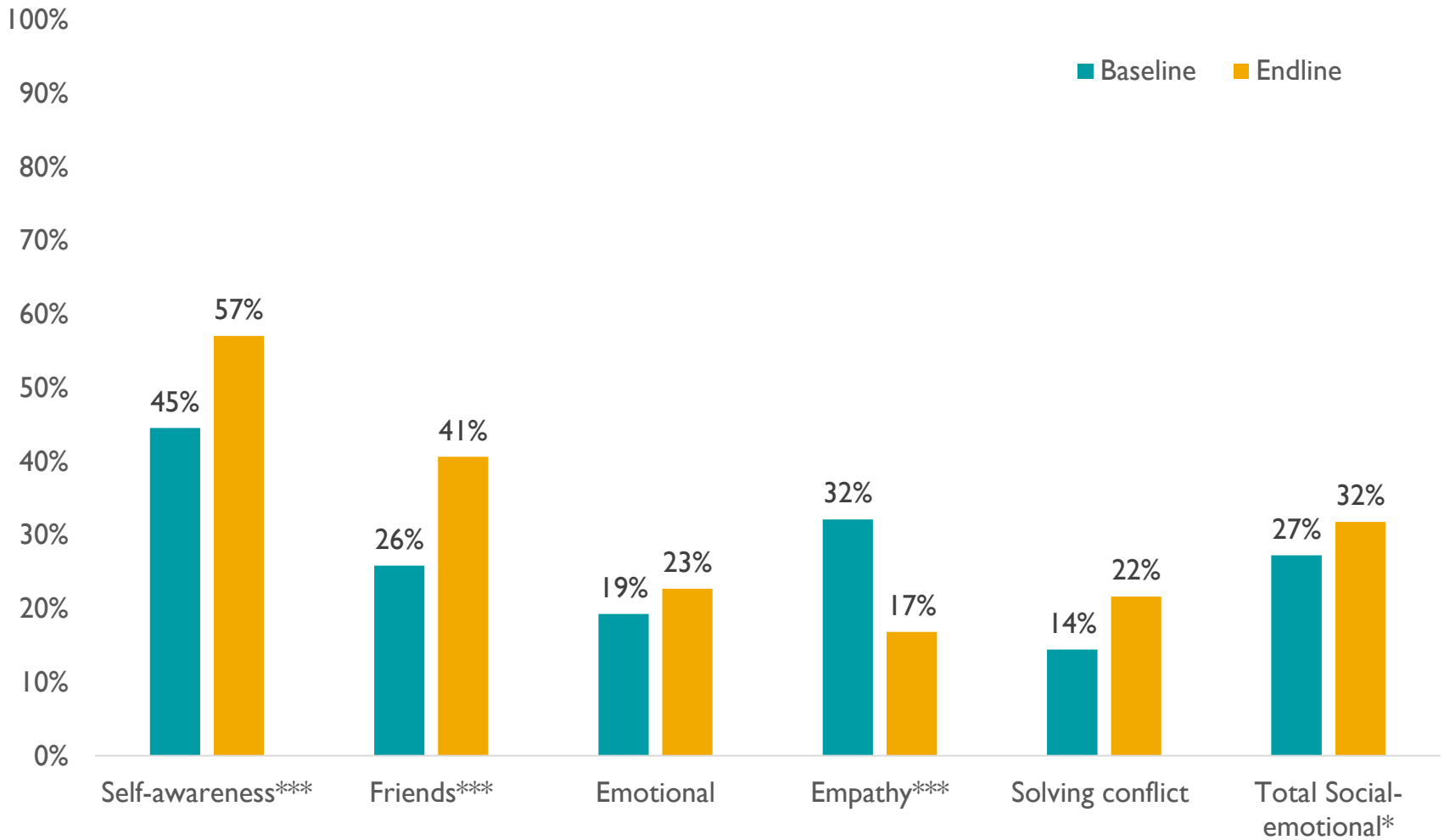

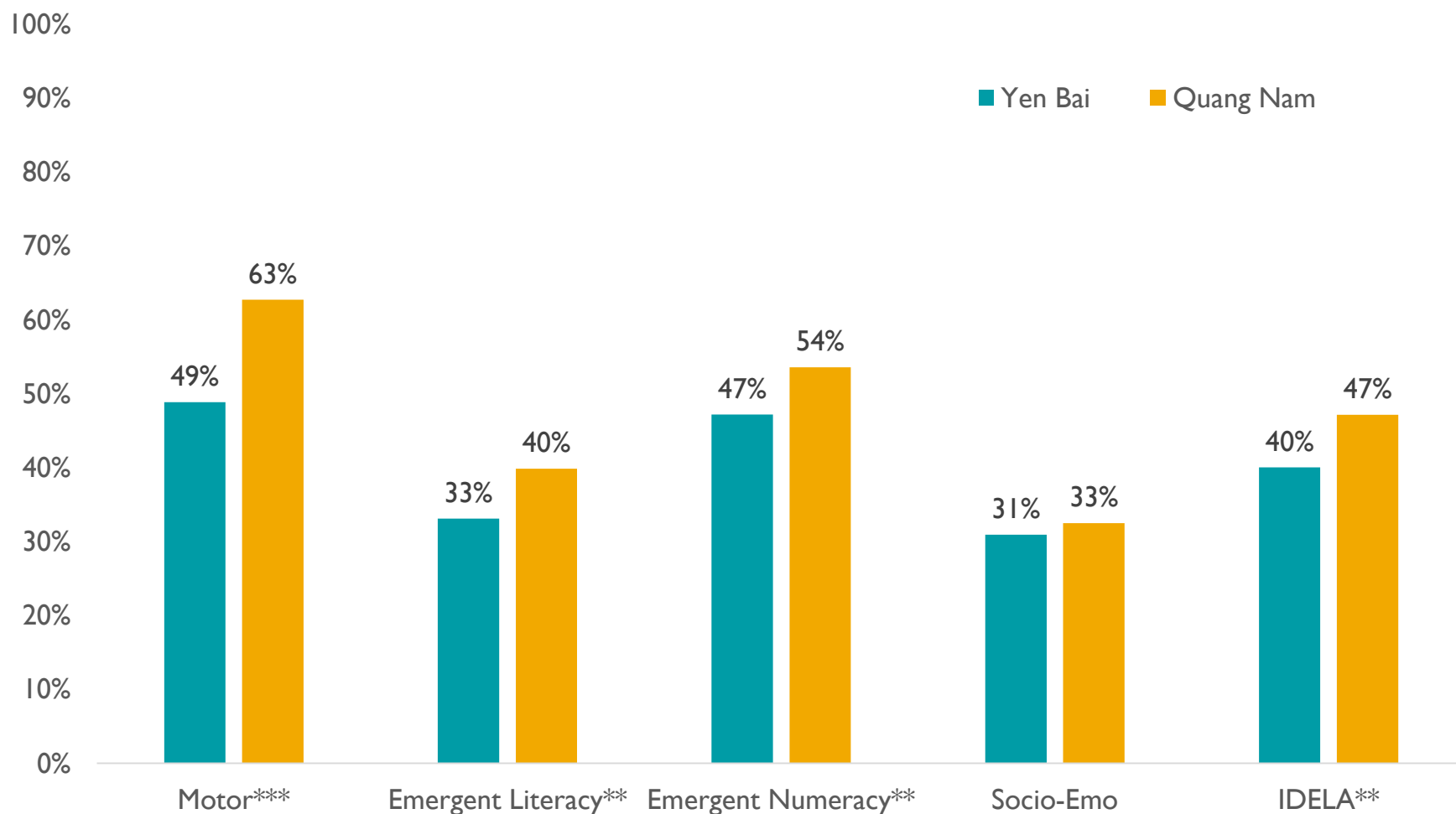

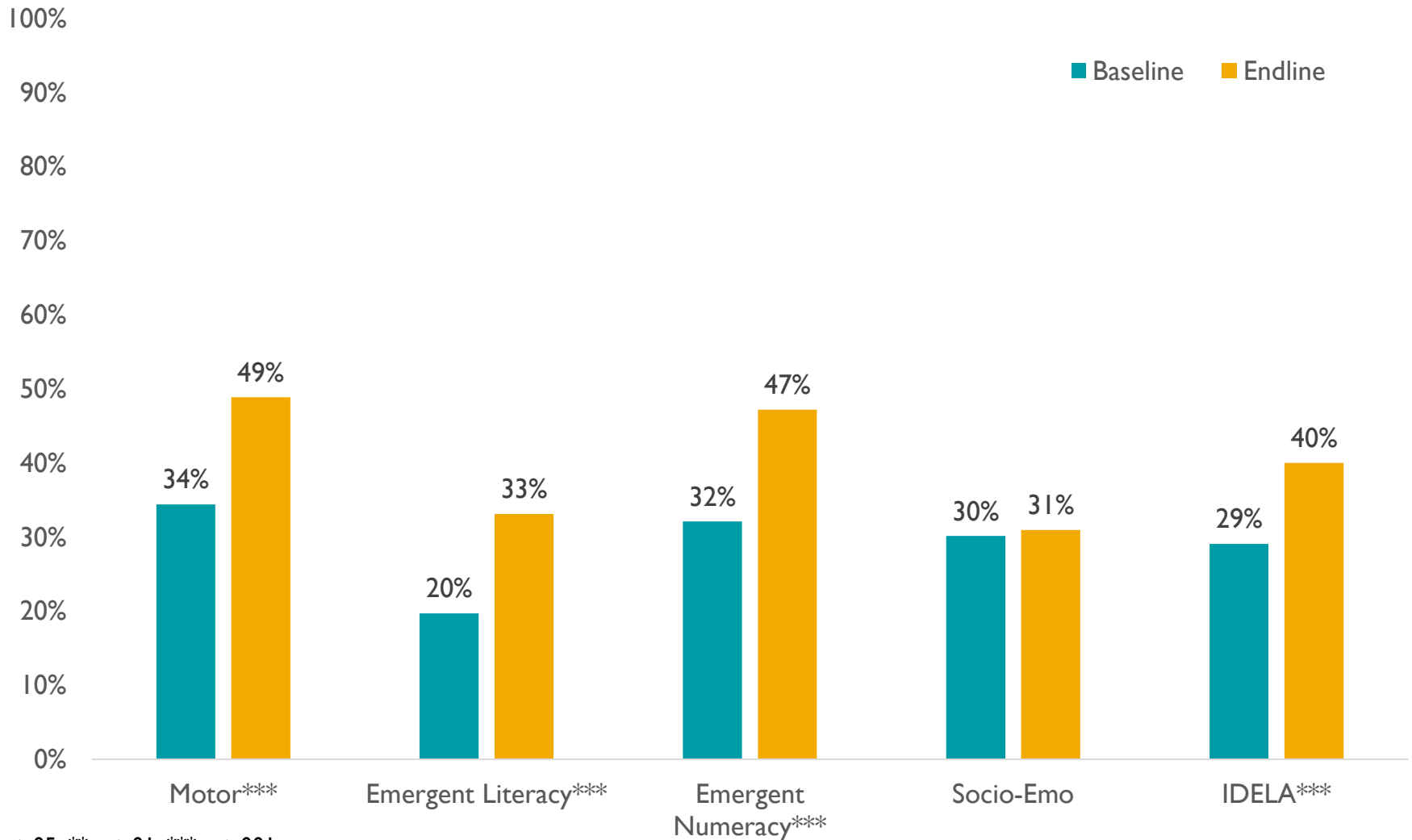
Skills by province

Skills.Yen Bai's IDELA subtests

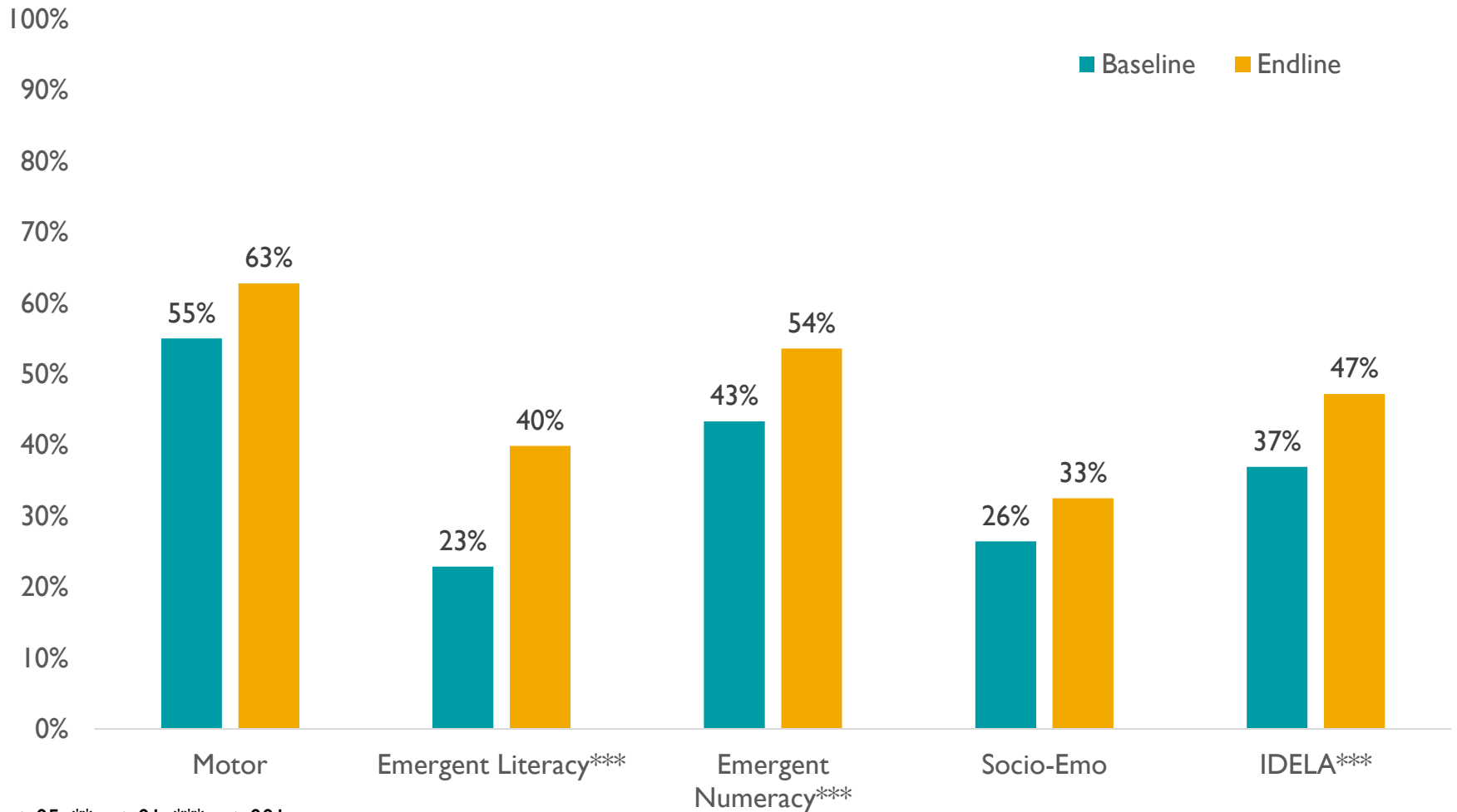

Family characteristics

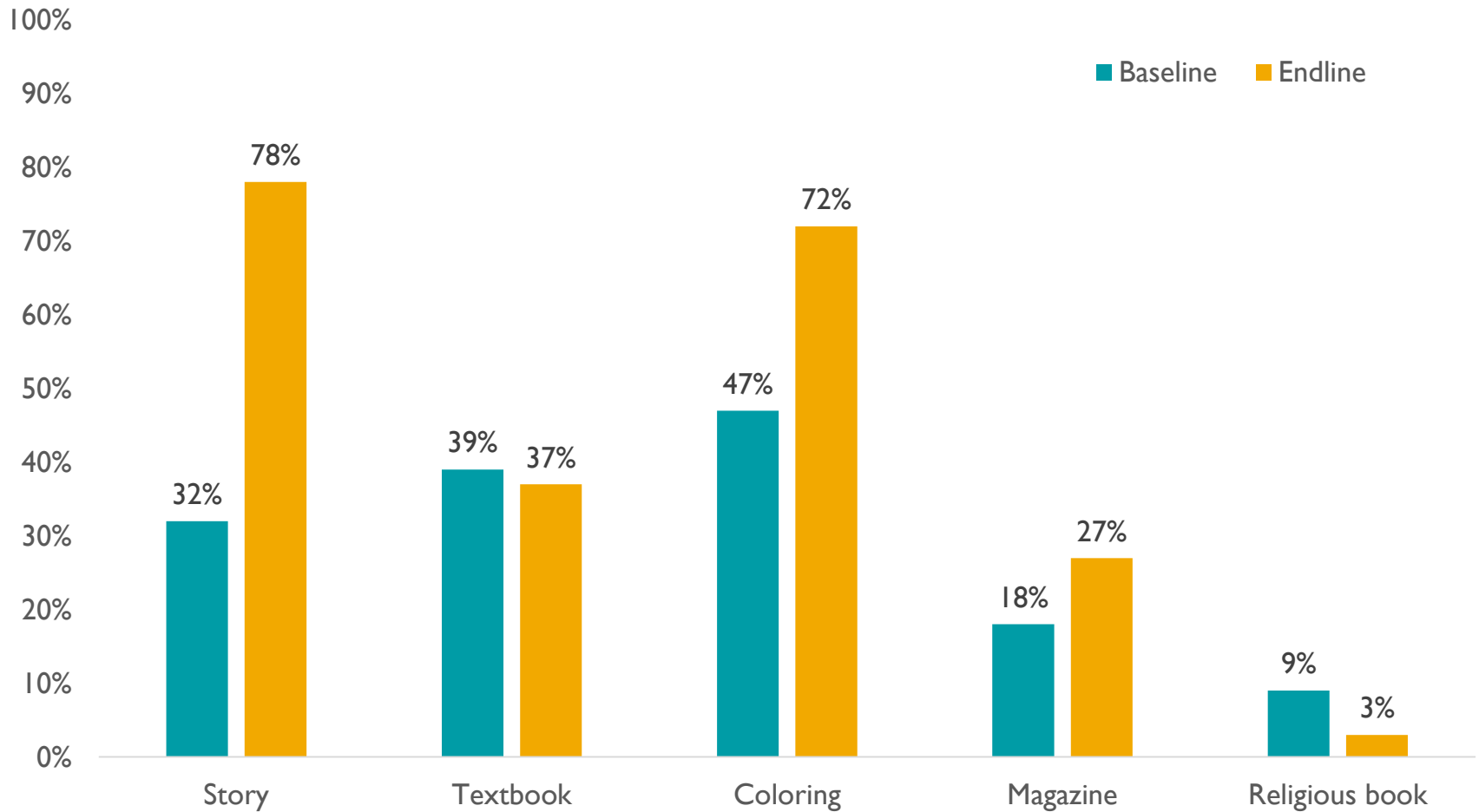
Characteristics of respondents are similar at baseline and endline. Mother age is higher, which is expected as the endline collected data from children and caregivers in the same cohort as those collected at baseline. *Viết thêm*

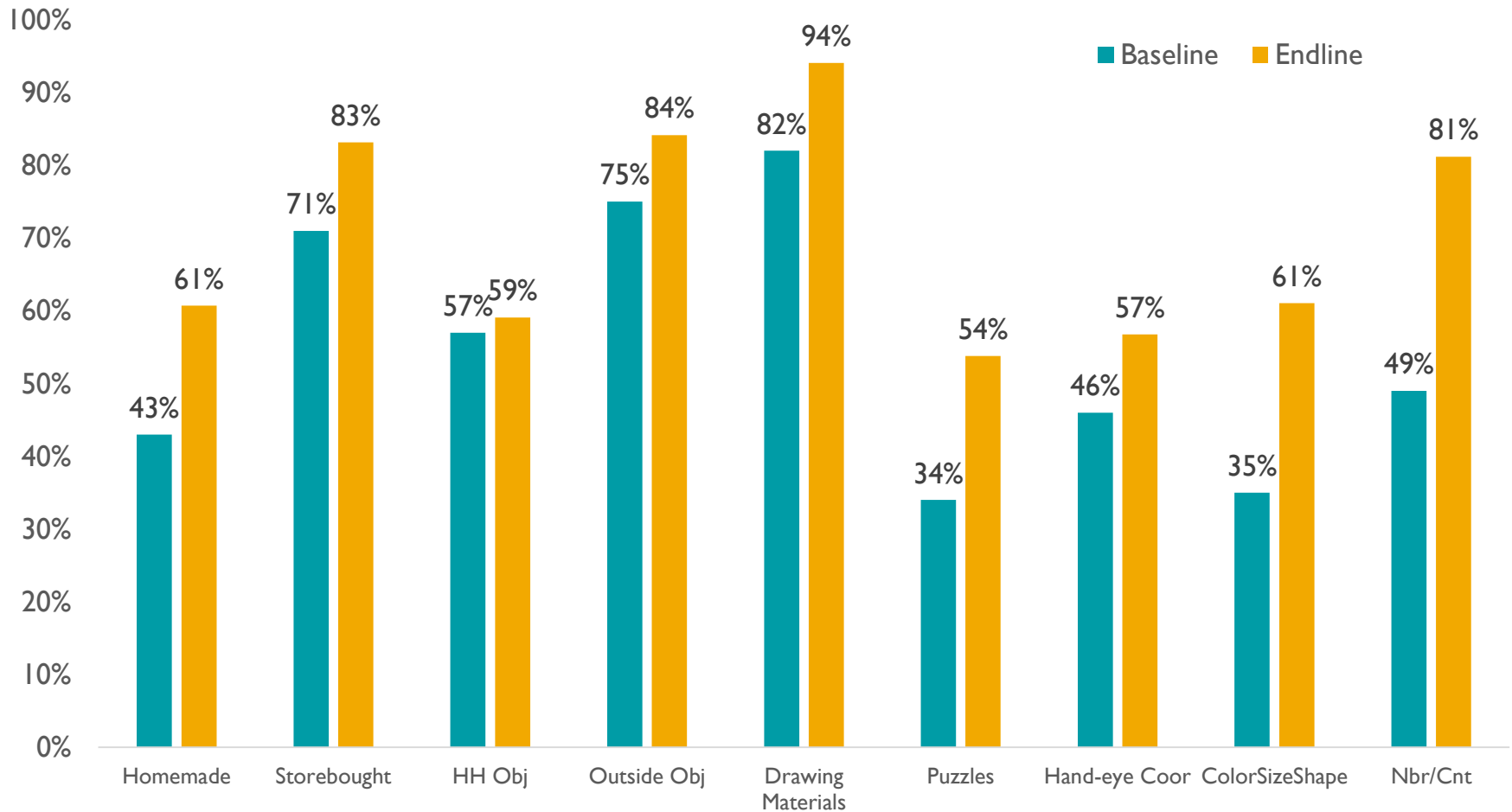
Home Literacy Environment. Books

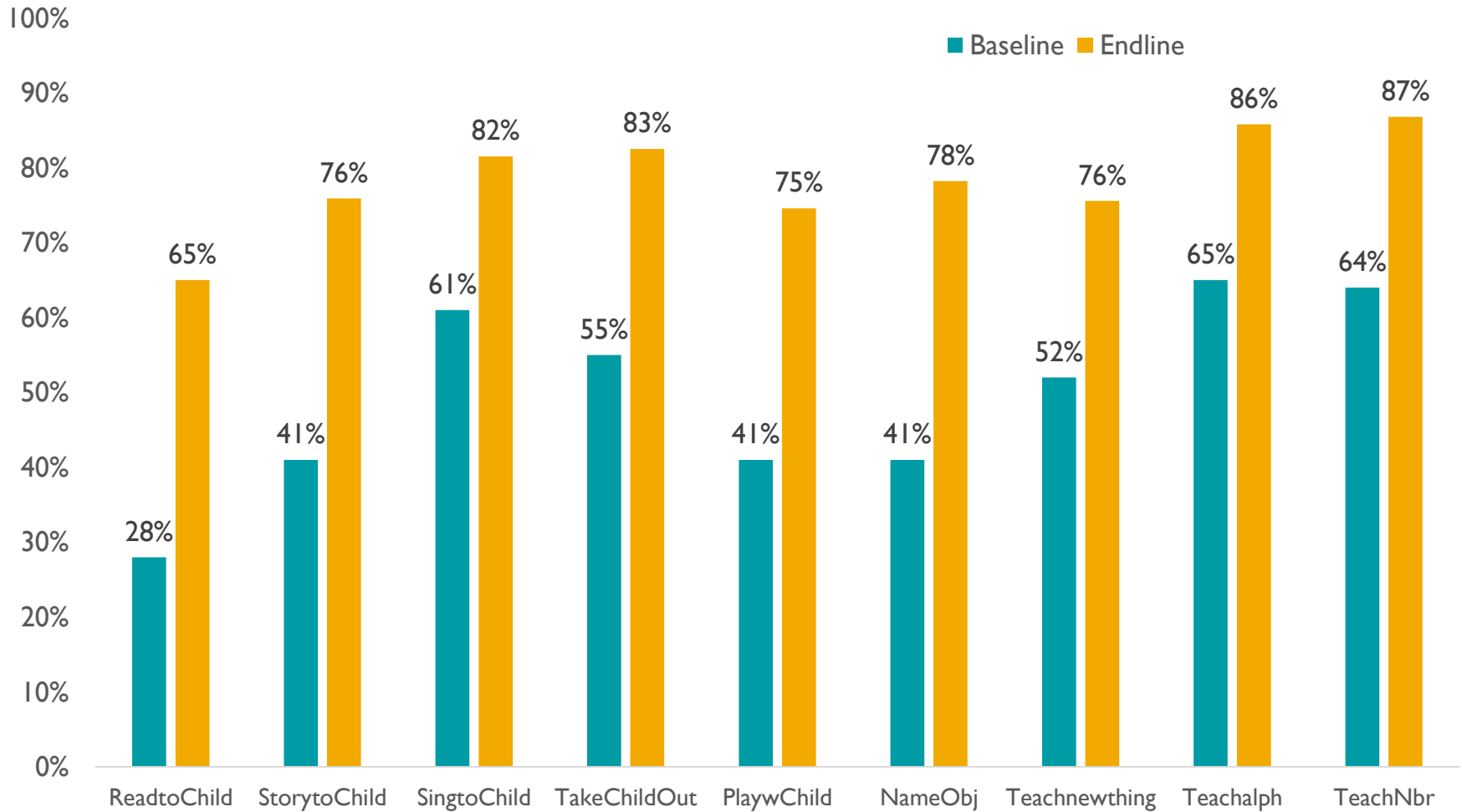
